

CCAF-FCVI Inc. is the new full name that was changed in 1980 from the Canadian Comprehensive Auditing Foundation—La Fondation Canadienne pour la Vérification Integrée. The name was changed to recognize that the organization needed to move beyond auditing and deal with other aspects of governance and management that are essential to strong accountability, good stewardship, and well-performing organizations.
