

GNWT Direct Deposit Payment Service

On July 2, 2002 the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) will be launching a new Direct Deposit service to have payments deposited to Canadian bank accounts of businesses, government entities, individuals, organizations and students. Employees who receive non-salary payments, such as travel advances, travel expense reimbursements, professional dues reimbursements, etc; students who receive financial assistance; and businesses and individuals who receive payments such as vendor payments and grants or contribution payments are eligible for the Direct Deposit service.

Through Direct Deposit, payees will receive money faster and with greater efficiency. This service is provided free of charge.

Benefits of Direct Deposit include:

- Elimination of delivery disruptions or lost mailings
- Elimination of time spent depositing and checking payments
- Payment in your account and available on the due date

Notification of payment may be received via one of the following options:

- Mail, Facsimile, or Email

and will include the same information provided on a cheque stub.
