On May 4, 2020 the Office of the Superintendent of Insurance announced that Insurance Agent, Salesperson and Adjuster licences expiring during the Territorial Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency (State of Emergency) would be granted an extension of ninety (90) days from the date on which the licence would otherwise expire.

As of Friday, April 1st at 12:00 a.m. the Public Health Emergency and associated public health orders were lifted, ending the state of emergency in the NWT.

**On May 4, 2022 at 12:00am MT:**

- 1. The ninety (90) day licence renewal extension for Insurance Intermediaries will end and licences will expire as of the date stated on the licence.**
- 2. In-person exams for the General Insurance Exam and LLQP will resume.**
