In accordance with subsection 14(1) of the Act, the Board considered an application for the transfer of a Class A premises licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 14(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

1. The Class A premises licence shall transfer to Irish Castle Pub for the establishment known as Irish Castle Pub, located at 5019 49th Street, in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday 3:00pm to 2:00am.
3. The maximum occupant load shall be 64 persons.
4. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the Act, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the Act.
