In accordance with subsection 14(1) of the Act, the Board considered an application for the transfer of a Class A premises licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 14(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

1. The Class A premises licence shall transfer to 508065 N.W.T. Ltd. for the establishment known as Doghouse Pub, located at 10J Gagnier Street, in Hay River, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Saturday 1:00pm to 2:00am.
3. The approved operating days and hours for the patio shall be: Monday to Saturday 1:00pm to 9:00pm.
4. The maximum occupant load shall be 90 persons.
5. The maximum occupant load for the patio shall be 52 persons.
6. The Banquet Room Extension is granted.
7. The maximum occupant load for the Escarpment Banquet Room shall be 52 persons.
8. The maximum occupant load for the Alexandra Banquet Room shall be 60 persons.
9. The maximum occupant load for the Louise Falls Banquet Room shall be 52 persons.
10. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the Act, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the Act.
