ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 11(2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

- 1. The Applicant shall be issued an amended licence for the establishment known as the Northern Arts and Cultural Centre, located at 4701- 52nd Avenue, Yellowknife, NT.
- 2. The Maximum Occupant Load for the theatre shall be 301 persons.
- 3. The Maximum Occupant Load of 301 persons for the lobby/concession area remains the same.
