

Application for the Transfer of a Class D Premises Licence

In accordance with subsection 14(1) of the Act, the Board considered an application for the transfer of a Class D premises licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 14(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

- 1. Pursuant to section 21.1 of the Regulations, the Minister waived the application requirements of a copy of the report from the Fire Marshal under section 5.1 of the *Fire Prevention Act* stating that the proposed licensed premises includes proper precautions against fire and the spread of fire.
- 2. The Applicant shall be issued a Class D premises licence for the establishment known as Blachford Lake Lodge, located at North Shore, Blachford Lake, NT.
- 3. The approved operating days and hours shall be Monday to Sunday 10:00am to 11:00pm.
- 4. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the Act, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the Act.
- 5. Prior to alcohol being served, server training certificates shall be provided to the Board no later than May 10th, 2024 as proof that the on-site manager and servers have taken the NWT server training within the last 24 months.
