In accordance with section 11 (1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for a Class D (Recreational) Premises Licence.

**ORDER**

Pursuant to section 11 (2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class D (Recreational) Premises Licence for the establishment known as Fort Smith Curling & Winter Sport Centre, located at 108 King Street, in Fort Smith, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Thursday 12:00pm to 10:00pm, Friday to Saturday 12:00pm to 2:00am, and Sunday 12:00pm to 8:00pm.
3. All workers are required to attend Alcohol Server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than February 1st, 2019.
4. The term of the licence is till March 31, 2019 but will terminate on February 2nd, 2019 if the Licence Holder fails to provide confirmation to the Board by February 1st, 2019 that all workers have completed alcohol server training through Liquor Enforcement.
5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
