In accordance with subsection 11 (1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for a Class A Premises Licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 11 (2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class A (Liquor Primary) Premises Licence for the establishment known as Harley's Hardrock Saloon, located at 4919 48th Street in Yellowknife as of this date.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday 10:00am to 2:00am.
3. The On-site Manager and all servers are required to attend or to have attended NWT Alcohol Server training provided through Liquor Enforcement within the last 24 months. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation that this requirement has been satisfied, (by way of copies of the training certificates) no later than March 31st, 2019.
4. The Licence Holder shall provide a Certified Criminal Record for Sara Murphy. The Certified Criminal Record shall be provided to the Board no later than March 31st, 2019.
