In accordance with subsection 11 (1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for a Class D Premises Licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 11 (2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

- 1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class D (Recreational) Premises Licence for the establishment known as the Hay River Curling Club, located at 77 Woodland Drive in Hay River as of this date.
- 2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Thursday 5:00pm to 2:00am, Friday to Saturday 12:00pm to 2:00am, and Sunday 12:00pm to 12:00am.
- 3. The On-site Manager and all servers are required to attend Alcohol Server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than June 30th, 2019.
- 4. The term of the licence is till March 31, 2020 but will terminate on July 1st, 2019 if the Licence Holder fails to provide confirmation to the Board by June 30th, 2019 that the On-Site Manager and all servers have completed alcohol server training through Liquor Enforcement.
- 5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
