In accordance with subsection 14 (1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for the transfer of a Class D Premises Licence.

## ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 14 (2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

- Class D Licence #2017-D-17 issued to Woodstove Catering Company Inc. shall transfer to NEW STAR LTD. as of this date. The establishment shall operate as Kingpin Centre, located at 5125 52nd Avenue in Yellowknife.
- The on-site manager and all servers are required to attend alcohol server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than June 30th, 2019.
- 3. The bar and liquor storage area shall be included in the licensed area.
- 4. The term of the licence is till March 31, 2020 but will terminate on July 1st, 2019 if the Licence Holder fails to provide confirmation to the Board by June 30th, 2019 that the on-site manager and all servers have completed alcohol server training through Liquor Enforcement.
- 5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
