In accordance with section 11 (1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for a Class A Premises Licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to section 11 (2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class A Premises Licence for the establishment known as Back Eddy Lounge, located at 2-6 Courtoreille Street, in Hay River, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Saturday 4:00pm to 2:00am.
3. All workers are required to attend Alcohol Server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than February 1st, 2019.
4. The Licence Holder shall provide completed Statutory Declarations and Criminal Records Checks, dated within 3 months of today's date, for Karen Rowe and Trudie Angela Schultz, no later than December 1st, 2018.
5. The term of the licence is till March 31, 2019 but will terminate on February 2nd, 2019 if the Licence Holder fails to provide confirmation to the Board by February 1st, 2019 that all workers have completed alcohol server training through Liquor Enforcement.
6. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
