In accordance with section 11(1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for a Class B Premises Licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to section 11(2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class B Premises Licence for the establishment known as Ambassador 5-Star Indian Restaurant, located at 201-5006 50th Avenue in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Friday 10:00am to 2:00am, Saturday 11:00am to 2:00am, and Sunday 11:00am to 12:00am.
3. All workers are required to attend Alcohol Server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than November 23rd, 2018.
4. The term of the licence is till March 31, 2019 but will terminate on November 24, 2018 if the Licence Holder fails to provide confirmation to the Board by November 23, 2018 that all workers have completed alcohol server training through Liquor Enforcement.
5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
