In accordance with subsection 11(1) of the Act, the Board considered an application for a Class D premises licence.

### ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 11(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class D premises licence for the establishment known as The Hungry Wolf Restaurant (The Nineteenth Hole) located at 10km South, Highway 3 South, in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be Monday to Sunday 10:00am to 2:00am.
3. The maximum occupancy load for the clubhouse shall be 130 persons.
4. The maximum occupancy load for the outside/seasonal use area shall be 45 persons.
5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the Act, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the Act.
