**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to subsection 14(2) of the Act, the Board orders the transfer of Class B (Food Primary) Liquor Licence #2017-B-07 from Licence Holder MBOTLAXO Investments Ltd. to Yellowknife Restaurant Limited Partnership effective November 28, 2017, with the following conditions:

- a) The establishment shall operate as Boston Pizza Yellowknife (Restaurant), located at 5102 - 48<sup>th</sup> Street in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories;
  - b) The approved operating days and hours are: Monday to Thursday, 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.; Friday to Saturday, 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.; and Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.;
  - c) The maximum occupancy load for the licensed area is 100 persons.
  - d) The Outside/Seasonal Use Area (Patio) is approved for the same days and hours as the approved operating days and hours for the Licensed Premises, with a Maximum Occupancy Load of 41 persons;
  - e) The Licence Holder shall post all signage as instructed by the Board.
2. Pursuant to section 83 of the *Liquor Regulations*, the Board waives the notice period for the issuance of this licence.
