1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class B Premises Licence for the establishment known as Zehabesha Restaurant, located at 5030 50th Street in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday - 10:00am to 11:00pm.
3. In addition to the requirements of the Act and Regulations, the following terms and conditions shall apply to this licence: All liquor must be kept and stored in non-public areas of the licensed premises.
