In accordance with section 11(1) of the Act, the Board considered an application for a Premises Licence.

ORDER

Pursuant to section 11(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

- 1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class A Premises Licence for the establishment known as Quarry Restaurant & **Lounge**, located at 4571-48th Street in Yellowknife, NT.
- 2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday 10:00am to 02:00am.
- 3. The Applicant's request for an off-premises extension is denied. The Applicant is free to reapply for this extension in one year should it have a clear liquor enforcement record.
- 4. All servers must attend Liquor Enforcement's server training within 3 months of commencing employment.
- 5. Pursuant to section 83 of the *Regulations*, the notice period for the issuance of this licence is waived.
