**ORDER**

Pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. Class A Premises Licence 2016-A-04 issued to 953781 NWT Ltd., shall transfer to the Applicant as of this date. The establishment shall operate as After 8 Pub, located at 5001 Forrest Drive in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Tuesday 6:00pm to 12:00am, Wednesday to Thursday 4:00pm to 12:00am, Friday 4:00pm to 2:00am and Saturday 2:00pm to 2:00am.
3. The Outside/Seasonal Use Area is approved with a maximum occupancy of 43 persons. The Licence Holder shall post all signage as instructed by the Board.
4. The approved operating days and hours for the Outside/Seasonal Use Area shall be: 1400 hours to 2230 hours on the licensed days of operation.
5. Pursuant to section 83 of the *Regulations*, the notice period for the issuance of this licence is waived.
