ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 14(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

1. The Class A premises licence shall transfer as of this date, to 506444 N.W.T. LTD. for the establishment known as Ice Breaker Lounge, located at 9410-100th Street, in Fort Simpson, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Thursday 5:00pm to 12:00am, and Friday to Saturday 5:00pm to 2:00am.
3. The maximum occupant load shall be 90 persons.
4. The approved days and hours for the Off-Premises Extension shall be: Monday to Saturday 5:00pm to 10:00pm.
5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the Act, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the Act.
