- The Applicant shall be issued a Class A Premises Licence for the establishment known as Copperhouse Eatery + Lounge (Lounge), located at 484 Range Lake Road in Yellowknife, NT.
- 2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday 10:00am to 2:00am.
- 3. All workers are required to attend Alcohol Server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
- 4. Pursuant to subsection 60(1) of the *Regulations*, patrons in the private dining area must be in maximum view from the bar and/or an alternative means of visual supervision at all times when there are patrons in the private dining area.
- 5. Liquor can only be transported between the restaurant and lounge areas by a worker.
- 6. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
