Pursuant to section 11(2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. The Applicant shall be issued a Class A Premises Licence for the establishment known as Copperhouse Eatery + Lounge (Lounge), located at 484 Range Lake Road in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday 10:00am to 2:00am.
3. All workers are required to attend Alcohol Server training through Liquor Enforcement. The Licence Holder shall provide confirmation to the Board no later than July 20th, 2018.
4. Pursuant to subsection 60(1) of the *Regulations*, patrons in the private dining area must be in maximum view from the bar and/or an alternative means of visual supervision at all times when there are patrons in the private dining area.
5. Liquor can only be transported between the restaurant and lounge areas by a worker.
6. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Liquor Act*, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the *Liquor Act*.
