ORDER

Pursuant to subsection 14(2) of the Act, the Board orders the following:

1. The Class B premises licence shall transfer as of September 1st, 2019 to DOULBLE YUMMY NWT LTD. for the establishment known as The Boardroom Restaurant, located at 891 Mackenzie Highway, in Hay River, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Sunday 11:00am to 10:00pm.
3. The maximum occupant load shall be 33 persons for the Dining Room.
4. The maximum occupant load shall be 34 persons for the Sunroom.
5. Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the Act, the Board exempts the applicant from the requirement to publish notice under subsection 9(1) of the Act.
