In accordance with section 14(1) of the *Act*, the Board considered an application for the transfer of a Premises Licence.

### ORDER

Pursuant to section 14(2) of the *Act*, the Board orders the following:

1. Class B Premises Licence 2016-B-22 issued to Woodstove Catering Co, shall transfer to the Applicant as of this date. The establishment shall operate as Thornton's on 51<sup>st</sup>, located at 5125 - 52 Avenue in Yellowknife, NT.
2. The approved operating days and hours shall be: Monday to Saturday 5:00pm to 1:00am and Sunday 10:30am to 9:00pm.
3. In addition to the requirements of the Act and Regulations, the following terms and conditions shall apply to this licence:
  - a) Satrohan Chankasingh shall, no later than October 28, 2016, apply for a Certified Criminal Record. Proof of such application shall be provided to the Board on or before that date. The Certified Criminal Record shall be provided to the Board within one week of Mr. Chankasingh receiving the Record.
  - b) Satrohan Chankasingh and Graham Shishkov shall each submit to the Board no later than October 28, 2016, newly sworn Statutory Declarations correctly stating their individual status as a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident.
4. Pursuant to section 83 of the *Regulations*, the notice period for the issuance of this licence is waived.
