General Insurance Exams

The Office of the Superintendent of Insurance (OSI) has reconvened the administration of in-person exams for the Northwest Territories General Insurance Examination. The exam consists of 100 multiple choice questions and must be completed in no more than 2 hours. Effective July 19th, exams will take place weekly from Monday to Wednesday at 9AM and 1:30PM. All exam sittings must be reserved a week in advance. Exam sittings are not reserved until they are confirmed by the OSI. All candidates must arrive 15 mins prior to their scheduled exam time to complete identity verification and discuss exam protocol. Exam reservations will automatically be cancelled and a new reservation will need to be made when the candidate is late for their confirmed exam time.

Life License Qualification Program (LLQP) Exams

The OSI will not be administering in-person LLQP exams as these exams are available online through our partner, Durham College. If you have successfully completed your requirements to write the Life License Qualification Program (LLQP) and would like to take your provincial/territorial exams, you must email the OSI with your full name and CIPR number. Once verification is complete, the OSI will inform Durham College of your eligibility to proceed, who will then contact you directly for registration and fee payment.
