



## Tł̨chq̨ All-Season Road – By the Numbers

The Government of the Northwest Territories, in partnership with North Star Infrastructure GP, is building a new all-season road, connecting the community of Whatì to Highway 3 near Behchokq̨. The new all-season road is being delivered through an integrated design, build, finance operate and maintain public private partnership, with a two to three-year construction period and 25-year operating, maintenance and rehabilitation period. The Project:

- Is 97 kilometers in length
- Is a 2-lane gravel road
- Includes significant requirements for local and First Nations involvement, including contractual obligations to utilize meaningful levels of local and Tł̨chq̨ First Nations labour and resources over the contract term
