



## Tłıchq All-Season Road – Questions and Answers

### Where will the road be built?

- The Tłıchq All-Season Road will start at Highway 3, west of Yellowknife near the community of Behchokq, and will provide year-round access to Whatı.
- In addition to providing year-round access to Whatı, the Tłıchq All-Season Road will increase the winter road season and improve access to Gamètı and Wekweètı.

### Value of the contract?

- The value of the contract with North Star Infrastructure GP over the 28 years is \$411.8 million, comprised of the following:

Service Payment – Capital Portion	<b>148.5</b> million
Service Payment – OMR Portion	<b>152.9</b> million

### Overall cost of the project?

- The total capitalized cost will be \$213.8 million, as follows:

Pre-development and construction	<b>\$ 184.1</b> million
GNWT costs	<b>29.7</b> million

- After the road goes into service in 2022, the GNWT will pay NSI \$10.4 million per year over the 25-year term, part of this payment is indexed at an assumed 2% per year (linked to actual CPI over the period)

### When will the road be finished?

- Early 2022

### What involvement do First Nations have in the Project?

- The Tłıchq Government is equity partner in North Star Infrastructure GP with an estimated \$16 million investment.
- North Star Infrastructure GP has signed up to a detailed training plan that requires it to employ and train Tłıchq Citizens into various roles through the construction, operations and maintenance periods. This will ensure that significant knowledge and capacity transfer occurs, building on the skills that already exist within the Tłıchq Communities.
- North Star Infrastructure GP is contractually obligated to ensure Tłıchq, Northern and Local Businesses deliver a meaningful proportion of the project, and achievement of these obligations will be carefully monitored by the GNWT.
